

PROVISIONS REGARDING THE PROCEDURE OF CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE

According the Order of the Romanian Ministry of Education No. 3693/2024 for the approval of the Frame-methodology regulating the admission to short-term, bachelor, master and doctoral higher education studies approved by the Board Decision No 11/10905/14.05.2024, Art. 25

According to Art. 6, paragraph 6 of the Order No. 3693/2024, published in the Official Monitor of Romania, *High-school graduates from internationally accredited systems recognised by the Romanian Ministry of Education have the right to participate in the admission process, including in the year when graduated high-school, and to be provisionally accepted, the admitted candidate having to submit the actual international baccalaureate/equivalent diploma no later than 6 months from graduation. If the admitted candidate does not submit the international baccalaureate/equivalent diploma the international baccalaureate/equivalent diploma within the established deadline, they will be expelled. This provision refers to any of the three situations below, already stipulated in the university admission requirements for international students:*

1. Graduates of the current year who haven't received the final diploma of international baccalaureate can apply with the following document: *Graduation certificate, official document valid only for graduates who have not received the final diploma of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam which contains and explicitly reflects the passing of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and the final results obtained by the candidate in this exam –* Chapter IV. 4 Documents required for the application to the admission exam.

2. In case of study documents that were issued by schools functioning according to the British system, we do not accept *predictive = hypothetical* results (candidates who haven't yet **passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam**). The university accepts only study documents reflecting the final and definitive grades obtained at the baccalaureate/equivalent exam. The GCE (General Certificate of Education) is obligatory; the GCE can be replaced by the Statement of Results, a document which explicitly reflects the fact that the candidate has successfully passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and contains the final results obtained

This provision has been set according to the provisions of the Centre for the Recognition and Validation of Diplomas of the Romanian Ministry of Education, that does not accept *predicted grades* either.

3. Graduates of the current year have the obligation to submit *the graduation certificate (the official document valid only for high school graduates who have not obtained the final diploma) of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam which contains and explicitly reflects the passing of the baccalaureate/equivalent exam and the final results obtained by the candidate in this exam.*

4. The mechanism and admission procedure for candidates coming from third countries takes place according to the admission requirements of the university, as follows: *Candidates are admitted on the basis of a competitive examination and are ranked in order of the choices made and the baccalaureate/equivalent average*.

5. The conditional acceptance has already been regulated according to the admission requirements for international candidates, by the following provision – Notarised statement – only for the candidates who submit the document mentioned in subchapter V. 11. 6 (4), i.e., by which they undertake to submit to the university their baccalaureate/equivalent diploma in original, legalized/super-legalized copy and authorized translation into Romanian immediately after obtaining it from the issuing high school. The deadline depends on the issuing country.

Considering the fact that according to the category of the candidate (EU, Romanians from Everywhere, third countries) the candidates of a certain category take the same type of admission, under the same conditions, introducing specific provisions that differentiate certain candidates by exempting them from certain mandatory provisions, means breaking the rules imposed by the ministry of education, leading to discriminatory and non-inclusive approach.

According to Article 10, paragraph 2 of the Order 3693/2024, the participation of a candidate in the admission exam is conditional on having passed the baccalaureate/equivalent exam, even if the candidate hasn't yet obtained the final diploma, and the *predicted grades* do not reflect this and cannot be accepted as final results.
